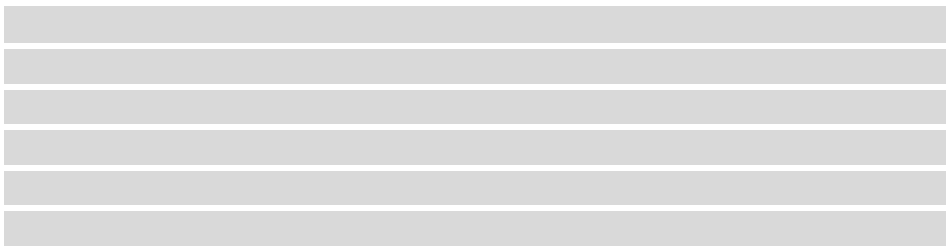

**Policies:**

Students pursuing the English-Journalism major are required to maintain at least a 2.5 GPA in English courses.

Transfer students must earn at least 16 credits at Edgewood College in English at the 300/400 level in addition to the four COR 3 seminar. Post-baccalaureate students are exempt from this requirement.

Courses required for the major are offered on a rotating basis. Students are urged to consult with the department chair or their advisor for information regarding this sequence.
