**Policies:**

In order to progress in the 12-Month Post-Baccalaureate BS program, students must maintain an academic cumulative GPA of 2.5, a cumulative GPA of 2.5 in all nursing courses, and a cumulative GPA of 2.5 in the required science and math courses.

A grade of “C” or better is required in each nursing, math and science course. A grade of Pass in each clinical course is required for progression into the next nursing course. If these requirements are not met, the student is not eligible to progress in the 12-Month Post-Baccalaureate BS program.
