**Policies:**

**PROGRESSION IN THE TRADITIONAL BS PROGRAM**

In order to progress in the Traditional BS program, students must maintain an academic cumulative GPA of 2.5, a cumulative GPA of 2.5 in all nursing courses, and a cumulative GPA of 2.5 in the required science and math courses.

A grade of “C” or better is required in each nursing, math, and science course. A grade of “Pass” in each clinical course is required for progression into the next nursing course. If these requirements are not met, the student is not eligible to progress in the Traditional BS program.

**POLICIES FOR REPEATING COURSES**

In accordance with College policy, a student may choose to repeat a course taken at Edgewood College to improve a poor or failing grade. Most courses cannot be repeated for additional credit. Only the most recent attempt at the course will be included in the GPA calculation, even if the most recent attempt at a course results in a lower grade. The credits for a course are earned only once, provided at least one of the attempts results in a passing grade. All repeated courses and their grades will appear on the transcript in the terms they were taken and repeated courses will be noted as “R” (Repeated). The repeated course grade is used to compute the GPA for the Traditional BS program. A course required for the Traditional BS program may be repeated only once for GPA calculation in the nursing GPA.
