

## **Policies:**

A minimum of **18 credits** in Business numbered 300 or above must be earned at Edgewood College. This rule is designed to assure that at least one-half of the credits applied to an Edgewood College Business Major be obtained through actual Edgewood College RBUS coursework. Once admitted to the RAAD program, all Business courses must be completed at Edgewood College.

For the purpose of this residency, credit by examination and credit through prior learning portfolios are counted as Edgewood College credits as long as no less than 32 credits in a student's entire program are taken directly through Edgewood College courses.

This applies to residency and not to the 18 credit rule. Exceptions to this rule will occur only in extreme circumstances and require prior written permission of both the student's academic advisor and the Dean of the School of Business. Students must complete RENG 151 as well as 40 credits of coursework before enrolling for business courses numbered 300 or above.
