

Policies:

Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher in RCS 108, RCS 117 and RCS 227, or written consent of the department before he/she may declare a major in the CIS Department.

A student must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher in all computer science courses in order to earn a major in the department.

All 400-level courses are residency courses and **MUST** be completed through attendance in classes in Edgewood College (some exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Department).

A minimum of three computer courses in the major at or above the 300 level must be taken in the Computer and Information Sciences Department at Edgewood College. Courses in computer science taken more than five years ago may not be accepted. Such courses are accepted at the discretion of the department.

Once admitted to the RAAD Program, all CIS courses must be completed at Edgewood College. Courses in the department may not be taken as Pass/Fail. Courses in the Department of Computer and Information Systems may not be audited.
